

Central Curry School District 1
School Board Special Meeting Summary

May 8, 2020

The Central Curry School District 1 Board of Directors met on Friday, May 8, 2020, in a special meeting to discuss the proposed furlough days for employees. The meeting was held virtually via Zoom.

In action items, the Board reviewed the proposed Memorandums of Understanding with the Central Curry Employees Association and the Central Curry School District 1 Classified Employees Association to consider furlough days during this school year. Proposals have employees participating in the Work Share Oregon program in conjunction with a federal COVID-19 relief fund. By taking furlough days now, the District will be able to save funds in anticipation of the funding shortfalls for the 2020-2021 school year. The Board approved the MOUs to have employees be furloughed at least one day a week through the end of their respective work calendars in June. In addition, all administration, confidential and supervisory staff will participate in the furlough.

Additionally, the Board approved the request to move the first meeting of the Budget Committee to Wednesday, June 3, 2020. Postponing the meeting one week from the original May 27 date will allow the administration to make adjustments to the proposed 2020-2021 budget after the May 20 state economic forecast and potential legislative action.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the board will be on Wednesday, May 20, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting will be conducted virtually via Zoom. The public is invited to attend this meeting.
